#### **VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES**

Two to three **Parish Finance Council Officers** <u>needed immediately</u>. Duties include attending quarterly meetings to advise the pastor on financial decisions regarding the parish. Basic accounting skills required, moderate to advanced skills preferred. One of these officers would be acting **Secretary**. Secretarial duties and qualifications similar to *Parish Pastoral Council Secretary* (see below). Direct all inquiries to Fr. Bond.

**Parish Pastoral Council Secretary** <u>needed immediately</u>.
