



PASTOR'S CORNER



Dear Parishioners-

It seems not everyone is aware of the precautions we are Taking here at St. Margaret's when it comes to current health concerns amid Covid-19. To ensure everyone has every possible access to the details of these precautions in order to make an informed decision for themselves and their families, they are being disseminated in all forms of media including our parish website, the bulletin, our Facebook page, and via email (for those who are included on our email list).

The precautions we are taking are as follows:

- The Church is deep cleaned once a week (including the bathroom).
- All "high touch" areas in the church are disinfected between each and every Mass including pew railings and door knobs. *Note: hymnals/ missalettes have been removed from the pews and holy water is only available in the metal dispensary in the narthex (not in the communal font as you come in).*
- During weekend Masses all windows and doors are left open and the ceiling fans are running so as to get as much air flow as possible.
- Every other row of pews is roped off to allow for a 6-foot distance front-to-back. Side-to-side spacing is not delineated, but congregants should maintain social distancing between households. Ushers will help to ensure this is achieved as much as possible.
- Just as doctors and healthcare professionals have recommended and encouraged the wearing of masks, I too am recommending and encouraging this precaution (although it is not a policy I wish to enforce upon entry). I, as the priest, will don a mask and wash and sanitize my hands just prior to distributing communion.
- During the Communion Rite, you are encouraged to join the procession to the foot of the sanctuary. If, however, you wish to remain outside, I will bring communion just beyond the front door of the church under the green canopy. It is here those who wish not to enter the church may receive communion. A limited number of chairs will be provided outside but you may also bring lawn chairs. The audio will be broadcast outside.
- Seeing as singing is believed to spread germs further than mere speaking, congregational singing will not be part of the Mass until further notice. As such, the choir will not be returning during this time.
- The shaking of hands and other human contact is to be avoided. Therefore, the Sign of Peace continues to be omitted during Mass.
