PARISH MEMBERSHIP: Welcome to Saint Margaret of Scotland Catholic Church! We are grateful for your worshipping with us. If you regularly attend Mass here in Maggie Valley, you are encouraged to register in the parish at the office during the week. Please note that a family must be registered at Saint Margaret’s in order for their children to be enrolled in our religious education program.

MARRIAGE: A new set of guidelines for weddings at Saint Margaret’s has been issued and is posted on the parish web site. Please note that only those who have some connection with this parish (such as being a member, or the child of a member) may get married here; weddings are also normally not scheduled during Advent or Lent because of the penitential nature of those seasons.
