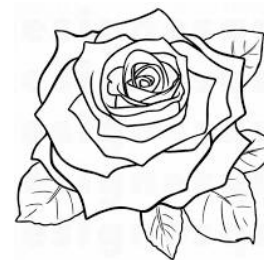
DAILY MASS: Mass is offered at 8:00 am daily. Mass on Saturday morning is from the Book of Divine Worship - The Missal.
