Weddings are not normally scheduled during Advent or Lent because of the penitential nature of those seasons.

DAILY MORNING AND EVENING PRAYER: Morning Prayer is read at 7:20 am daily, and Evening Prayer is read at 5:00 pm daily. Books are available for those who wish to participate; all are welcome.

DAILY MASS: Mass is offered at 8:00 am daily. Mass on Saturday morning is from the Book of Divine Worship - The Missal.
