PARISH MEMBERSHIP: Welcome to St. Margaret of Scotland Catholic Church! We are grateful for your worshipping with us. If you regularly attend Mass here in Maggie Valley, you are encouraged to register in the parish at the office during the week. Please note that a family must be registered at St. Margaret's in order for their children to be enrolled in our religious education program.

BREAKFAST WITH BECKET: On Thursday mornings, right after 8:00 AM Mass, and continuing through the summer, we will be having a Bible Study on the Book of Revelation. There will be coffee and tea, and assorted pastries. Weather permitting, we will meet in the garden outside of the pastor's office. This week we will discuss Revelation Ch.4. All are welcome.

DAILY MORNING AND EVENING PRAYER: **Morning Prayer** is read at **7:20 am daily**, and **Evening Prayer** is read at **5:00 pm daily**. Books are available for those who wish to participate; all are welcome.

BECOMING CATHOLIC: If you are interested in becoming a Catholic, whether or not you have already been baptized in another non-Catholic church, please get in touch with the pastor (e-mail is best) or the parish office. We welcome you and look forward to sharing our faith.

VISITING THE SICK: Please call the parish office to arrange for Communion or for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.

COFFEE AND DONUTS: We are looking for volunteers to host coffee and donuts after 10 AM Mass starting in June. Please contact the parish office if interested.

CLOSURE OF ACCESS: Beginning 27 May, Murphy Drive will be closed with temporary barriers between the church property and the Valley Creek Run neighbourhood near the gravel lot. These measures are being taken to ensure our parishioners' safety and to encourage proper traffic flow.

We are exceptionally blessed and grateful to our parishioners for their generosity to our parish and diocese. We are well on our way to meeting our assessment in the Diocesan Support Appeal (DSA) for this year. I am happy to let you know of two special notices for our parish's participation in DSA this year:

1. All money raised above and beyond the parish's assessment is returned to the parish as a rebate, and thus does not count as parish income and is not counted in calculating the annual assessment. I have designated any rebate we may get during this coming year for replacing some, or perhaps all, of the windows in the chancel. They would all be tinted, tempered glass; it would keep the sanctuary a little cooler, have less glare in the live stream, and still reveal the spectacularly beautiful view. And, as I said several weeks ago, if you don't want to do it for the parish or the diocese, at least have pity on the poor titmouse throwing itself against the window every day.

2. A generous donation has provided matching funds for all contributions made to the DSA from this parish after 1 May -- that **doubles** your contribution! This is good for both new pledges made after 1 May and those portions of pledges made previously but paid after 1 May. Sometimes people may not keep track of how much of a balance remains on their pledge, and in other cases people's financial situation changes. The matching funds will not replace our parish's contributions, but enhance them, and should enable us to meet our assessment and have a substantial amount of rebate to replace the windows in 2022. So please keep up the good work, which benefits the diocese, the parish, and our beautiful church building.
