**DAILY MASS:** Mass is offered at 8:00 am daily. Homilies at weekday Masses this week focus on the *Book of Numbers*. Mass on Saturday morning is from the *Book of Divine Worship: The Missal*.

**GET INVOLVED:** There are currently many opportunities for service available within St. Margaret's. Both regular and seasonal members are invited to offer their time and talents in a variety of ways. This is also a wonderful way to connect with other parishioners. - **ALTAR SERVERS (ADULTS + YOUNG PEOPLE)** - Altar Servers assist the priest celebrant at the altar and throughout the Liturgy. The altar server should have a good understanding of the Mass structure and prayers. This ministry is open to both males and females, after reception of first Communion.
- **LECTORS (WEEKEND)** - The ministry of lector includes proclaiming the Scripture and Prayers of the Faithful at the Church's worship. Lectors should have a good understanding of the Mass structure and prayers. Lectors should also have a clear speaking voice and be confident reading in front of large groups. Open to all who have received First Communion and Confirmation.
- **USHERS (WEEKEND)** - The men and women who serve as ushers foster a spirit of reverence and warmth when our parish gathers for the Eucharist. They greet parishioners and visitors as they enter the church, look after those with special needs, and collect the offertory collection. Couples and families, parents and teens, are invited to serve together. Rotating schedule.
- **OFFERTORY COUNTERS (TUESDAY MORNINGS)** - Duties include working with an accountability team of other volunteers and the parish secretary to ensure the monies collected from the weekend Masses are properly accounted for. Rotating schedule.
