Your support helps the church minister in parishes, provide Catholic schools and offer religious education; the Pontifical Good Friday Collection also helps to preserve the sacred shrines. THE BLESSING OF EASTER BASKETS has been a cherished Catholic ritual for centuries among families of Eastern European origin and adopted by people of all ethnic backgrounds who enjoy this richly symbolic custom. On Holy Saturday, families would prepare their



Easter Baskets to be later blessed at church. Traditionally, the baskets include: would decorated (representing hardboiled eggs Resurrection), Christ's lambshaped butter or sugar (representing Christ as the "Lamb of God"), bread (symbolic of Jesus the "Bread of Life"), ham of great joy (symbolic abundance), sausage (symbolic of

God's favor and generosity), smoked bacon (symbolic of the overabundance of God's mercy), some prefer lamb (representing Christ as the "Lamb of God"), salt (symbolic of prosperity and justice and to remind us "You are the salt of the earth"), cheese (symbolizes the moderation Christians should have at all times), horseradish & pepper (symbolic of the Passion of Christ and the bitter herbs of the Passover). Please join us with your unique baskets for a brief blessing on HOLY SATURDAY AT 3:00 PM, as we share this beloved tradition.
