COFFEE AND DONUTS: There will be coffee and donuts after 10:00 am Mass. Please join us for fellowship outside of the church under the umbrella.

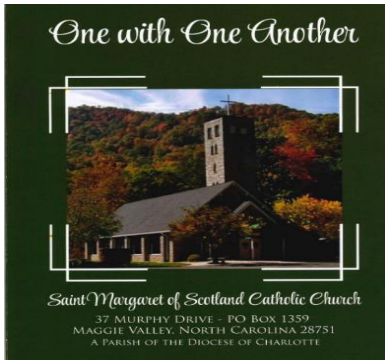
