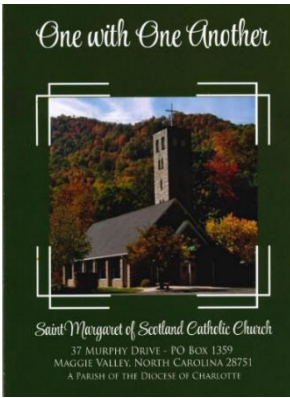

The parish has implemented a process to ensure accountability of campaign donor monies. Once a completed pledge card is received by the Builder in a sealed envelope, it will be given to the Parish office who will enter the pledge into the computer system. All of your pledge amounts by cash, check or credit card must clearly state your name and the words “Rectory Repairs Campaign”.
