THE BLUE RIDGE CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN GUILD OF ORGANISTS is sponsoring a presentation by Fr Becket Soule on **Soli Deo Gloria – Johann Sebastian Bach as Theologian and Preacher** at Saint Barnabas' Church in Arden, NC on **Sunday, 14 April 2024 at 3:00 PM**. This lecture will peel away the various levels of theological demonstration in his works, beginning with the *St Matthew Passion*, continuing with settings of the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and the Ten Commandments, and concluding with the theological underpinnings of the *Passacaglia and Fugue in c minor*. Bach wrote that 'the aim and final end of all music should be none other than the glory of God and the refreshment of the soul,' and his intention to praise God, preach God's Word, and encourage his hearers is there throughout all his music.
