MEMBERSHIP: Welcome to St. Margaret of Scotland Catholic Church! We are grateful for your worshipping with us. If you regularly attend Mass here in Maggie Valley, you are encouraged to register in the parish at the office during the week.

DAILY MORNING AND EVENING PRAYER: Daily Morning Prayer is at 7:20 AM and Daily Evening Prayer is at 5:00 PM, according to the *Book of Divine Worship*.

DAILY MASS is celebrated at 8:00 AM. Mass on Saturday morning is taken from the *Book of Divine Worship: The Missal*. **Please check the calendar for schedule changes and modifications.**

BREAKFAST WITH BECKET will meet on **Wednesday, 3 July, 8:45 am** in the Parish Hall with Exodus 29: *The consecration of the priests*. God takes seven actions to consecrate the priests in Exodus 29:1-43 (depending on how you subdivide the verses). What were some of those actions? How do those actions resemble the same actions God takes to set us apart and make us holy in Jesus? How long did this process take? Why do you think God told them to do it for such a long time? Construction on the LEGO® Tabernacle will start soon!

AQUINAS CIRCLE will meet on **Tuesday, June 25** in the Parish Hall at 4:00 PM. **IaIIae q. 17: Command.** Acts such as intention, consent, and election, are acts *elicited* by the will; these acts are begun and completed in the will itself. Other acts, carried out by the intellect or the sentient and bodily powers, are *commanded* by the will. *Command* is an order of reason (the “counselled” will) for the carrying out of an intention. *Reason* (which is the intellect and will together) governs the sensitive appetites; sometimes, however, sensitive appetites are aroused by conditions of the body which are not subject to reason, and sometimes the sensitive appetites are so suddenly aroused that they elude, at least momentarily, the control of reason. But reason has no control over a person’s vegetal or plant functions, such as growth: “No man, by taking thought, can add to his stature one cubit.” Join us on Tuesday and look at this distinction more closely.

There is no Biblical **HEBREW** on **Thursday, 27 June**. Classes will resume on **Wednesday, July 10** [Note the change in day that week] in the Parish Hall at 4:00 PM. No previous language study is necessary.
