BREAKFAST WITH BECKET will meet on **Wednesday, 31 July, 8:45 am** in the Parish Hall with Exodus 33: *Moses intercedes for the people*. Why would Moses go out to the tent? Who else could go out and why? What does v. 11 show us about Moses' relationship to God? How does God speak with us? What was Moses' request of God this time? Why do you think he asked this of God? Did God agree to Moses' request? Why did God not allow Moses to see His face? What *did* Moses see? Why do you think Moses didn't describe what he saw there? Come and see the construction of the LEGO® Tabernacle!

AQUINAS CIRCLE will meet on **Tuesday, July 30** in the Parish Hall at 4:00 PM. **IaIIae q. 22: The Emotions**. Aquinas now turns to what he calls the "Passions of the Soul," but which we usually translate as the "Emotions." Aquinas holds that people undergo emotions as they are acted on or, perhaps better, as they react to what they are aware of around them; we can react to the world or be affected by it at different levels. Join us on Tuesday and look at this distinction more closely.
