AQUINAS CIRCLE will meet on Tuesday, September 10, in the Rectory Living Room at 4:00 PM. **IaIIae q. 27: The cause of love.** St. Thomas distinguishes the good from the beautiful. Something is **good** to the extent that when it is possessed, as the appetite "comes to rest" *in it itself* (this is enjoyment or pleasure or joy). By contrast, something is **beautiful** to the extent that the appetite comes to rest in the *perception of it*. This is why the two senses that are "maximally cognitive," viz., sight and hearing, are especially sensitive to the beautiful. So, St. Thomas concludes, "it is clear that *beautiful* adds to *good* a certain power." (Interesting, eh?) Join us to learn more about this first of the emotions.
