MEMBERSHIP: Welcome to St. Margaret of Scotland Catholic Church! We are grateful for your worshipping with us. If you regularly attend Mass here in Maggie Valley, you are encouraged to register in the parish at the office during the week.

DAILY MORNING AND EVENING PRAYER: Daily Morning Prayer is at 7:20 AM and Daily Evening Prayer is at 5:00 PM, according to the *Book of Divine Worship*. **DAILY MASS** is celebrated at 8:00 AM. Mass on Saturday morning is taken from the *Book of Divine Worship: The Missal*.

BREAKFAST WITH BECKET will meet on **Wednesday, September 25 at 8:45 am** in the Rectory Living Room with Exodus 40: *God's Glory fills the Tabernacle*. In our modern society, how can we create spaces that are "holy" or set apart for God? How does the establishment of the tabernacle model the importance of community in worship? How does the concept of the divine presence traveling with the Israelites influence our understanding of God's relationship with us today? How do you think the Israelites felt when they saw the glory of the Lord filling the tabernacle? How does the tabernacle setting and anointing process relate to the importance of order and sanctity in our present-day worship spaces? Come and see the completed LEGO® Tabernacle! **We continue with the Book of Leviticus on Wednesday, 2 October.**

AQUINAS CIRCLE will meet on **Tuesday, September 24**, in the Rectory Living Room at 4:00 PM. **IaIIae q. 29: Hate.** If we grant that our emotions proceed from what we take to be good for us, we might ask, "Can we hate ourselves?" Aquinas turns to this question in IaIIa, q. 29, art. 4 and argues that in one way we cannot hate ourselves but in another way we can. Can we hate truth? Aquinas replies that, though one cannot explicitly hate goodness or being or truth in general, one can hate truth if one finds it unpleasant for some reason. Join us to learn more about these very vital distinctions.

Biblical **HEBREW** will meet on **Thursday, September 26** in the Rectory at 4:00 PM. No prior language experience required.
