MEMBERSHIP: Welcome to St. Margaret of Scotland Catholic Church! We are grateful for your worshipping with us. If you regularly attend Mass here in Maggie Valley, you are encouraged to register in the parish at the office during the week.

DAILY MORNING AND EVENING PRAYER: Daily Morning Prayer is at 7:20 AM and Daily Evening Prayer is at 5:00 PM, according to the *Book of Divine Worship*. **DAILY MASS** is celebrated at 8:00 AM. Mass on Saturday morning is taken from the *Book of Divine Worship: The Missal*.

BREAKFAST WITH BECKET will meet on **Wednesday, October 23** at **8:45 am** in the Rectory Living Room, *continuing with Leviticus 4: The Peace Offering*. What is the significance of differentiating between intentional and unintentional sins? What message does the ritual of laying hands on the animal's head convey about guilt and responsibility? How does this chapter challenge our perceptions of sin and guilt? How does the principle of unintentional sins challenge our understanding of justice?

AQUINAS CIRCLE will meet on **Tuesday, October 22**, in the Rectory Living Room at 4:00 PM. **IaIIae q. 33: The effects of pleasure**. Immersion in bodily pleasure can impede reason's exercise, Aquinas thinks, since it can lead one partly or wholly to ignore what reason might suggest, since it can lead one to act imprudently, and since it might just mess up one's ability to reason well, as, for instance, in the case of excessive pleasure indulged in with respect to alcohol. On the other hand, Aquinas is not of the view that pleasure inevitably results in those enjoying it ending up in a bad way. Insofar as one takes pleasure in what is good, he argues, pleasure positively completes one's being drawn to the good in question and can make one even more focused on it. See how that can be so this Tuesday.

Biblical **HEBREW** will meet next on **Thursday, 7 November** in the Rectory at 4:00 PM. No prior language experience required.

WORLD MISSION SUNDAY is **20 October 2024**. A second collection will be taken up world-wide for the Pontifical Mission Societies. This is an extremely important collection for the mission church because it provides for an annual subsidy and up to three special projects for around 1000 dioceses. Please be generous.

ALL SAINTS' DAY: Friday, 1 November 2024 is the Feast of All Saints; this year in the United States it is a Holy Day of Obligation. In addition to the usual 8:00 AM Mass, Mass will be at 6:00 PM.

ALL SOULS' DAY: Beginning 2 November and for thirty days afterwards, Masses will be said for the repose of the souls of the names submitted. **Envelopes are available to include the names of the faithful departed; these may be placed in the collection or turned in to the parish office.** The envelopes will be on the altar for thirty days; the names and special prayers will be on a prayer card for All Souls' Day. Names must be in the parish office by Wednesday, 30 October.
