Call the parish office to arrange for Communion for the ill or the homebound, or for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.

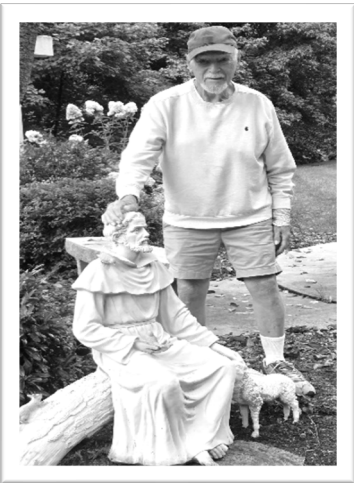
