FROM THE PASTOR

Although we are graced by the indwelling of the Holy Spirit from our baptism, as disciples of Jesus Christ, as Christians, as Catholics, we must freely choose to open ourselves up to the gifts of mercy and compassion that God constantly offers us. We must choose to live our lives as Christians, taught by Jesus, in the faith of the Catholic Church, and not as those who practice vengeance.

In the first reading taken from the book written by Jesus, the son of Eleazar, son of Sirach, we are told that it is God=s Will that children honor their parents. For whoever honors ones father atones for sins. One stores up riches who reveres his or her mother. The reality is that each and everyone of us are sinners.
